

Sir Roy Strong CH

Sir Roy Strong CH was born in 1935 and educated at Edmonton County Grammar School and the University of London. He joined the National Portrait Gallery in 1959 and became its director in 1967. In 1974 he became the Director of the Victoria & Albert Museum, a post which he resigned in 1987 to



pursue a freelance career in the media as a writer and consultant. He was knighted in 1983 and made a Companion of Honour in 2016. Over the years Sir Roy has written extensively on the country's history and culture as well as a long series of books on garden history and design. Amongst those for whom he has designed or assisted with their gardens are King Charles III, at his gardens in Highgrove, Sir Elton John and the late Gianni Versace.

Sir Roy gifted The Laskett to Perennial in 2021, allowing this very private and personal garden created through the love of a very happy marriage to be enjoyed by the public. In doing so he is supporting the valuable work of Perennial in helping all those who work in horticulture and their families.
