6 Tips for School Uniform Savings



- 1 Help from your local council**
In parts of the UK local authorities provide help with school uniform costs. You can use the Government postcode checker tool, but this support isn't available everywhere.
- 2 Support from your school**
It is always worth asking your child's school directly about their uniform policy and what support is available from them or in your local area.
- 3 Supermarket uniforms**
Some supermarkets offer generic uniforms – plain coloured, with no unique school badges – which are great value, if allowed.

- 4 Sales throughout the year**
Keep an eye out throughout the year. You can often get great deals and you can buy bigger sizes for your children to grow into.
- 5 Buy pre-loved uniform**
Ask about your school's pre-loved school uniform sales or check your local charity shops as a great way to save money and be eco friendly too.
- 6 Online marketplaces**
Local Facebook Marketplace and other sites such as eBay can be another great place to pick up a bargain.
