

Example wording for leaving a gift in your will

However, you can take the wording examples below with you to help ensure your wishes to leave a gift in your will to Perennial are carried out accurately.

1. Residuary Gift Example Wording

2. Pecuniary Gift Example Wording

I give the sum of (..... pounds) to Gardeners' Royal Benevolent Society (otherwise known as "Perennial"), a company limited by guarantee with company number 8828584 and a registered charity in England and Wales with registered charity number 1155156 and a registered charity in Scotland with registered charity number SC040180 and the receipt of the Treasurer or proper officer for the time being of Perennial shall be a complete discharge to my Executors.

3. Specific Gifts Example Wording

I bequeath my ______ (e.g. property, shares, jewellery, furniture, etc) to Gardeners' Royal Benevolent Society (otherwise known as "Perennial"), a company limited by guarantee with company number 08828584 and a registered charity in England and Wales with registered charity number 1155156 and a registered charity in Scotland with registered charity number SC040180 and the receipt of the Treasurer or proper officer for the time being of Perennial shall be a complete discharge to my Executors.
